- Share something new or a highlight from this past week.

## REVIEW

Open your Bibles and read from **1 Corinthians 15:1-28**.

- Share your favourite points from the weekend sermon. What spoke to you?
- Share a phrase or moment that you related to the most, or a question you may have from the weekend.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- What is one piece of advice that you were told as a child that you have never forgotten?
- Why is the death and resurrection of Jesus essential to the Christian faith? What does Jesus' resurrection have to do with us?
- What does "Christ died for our sins" mean to you?
- How does the Gospel affect your life on a daily basis?
- What evidence can you offer that Christ is alive in your life?
- How do you connect Christ's resurrection with your hope of resurrection from death?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?

## **PRAISE & PRAYER POINTS**

Share what God is doing in your life and spend some time praying for each other's prayer requests.

## APOSTLES' CREED

Close by reading the Apostles' Creed:

*I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.*

*And in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontus Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.*

*He descended to hell, on the third day rose again from the dead, ascended to heaven, sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty, thence he will come to judge the living and the dead.*
