- Share a phrase or moment that you related to the most, or a question you may have from the weekend.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- If you could live anywhere in the world, where would you like to live?
- What does being human mean to you?
- How does the story of creation affect the way you treat and respond to the world we live in?
- What does it mean for you to be created in God's image? How does knowing this affect how you feel about yourself?
- How does knowing you are created in God's image affect your relationship with God? With other people?
- How has your concept of God changed? How do you view God now?
- Have you ever felt alone? How did you make it through that time? What do you need from this group to feel more connected to others?
- How can you apply the story of Job to your life? What will you do about it?

Share what God is doing in your life and spend some time praying for each other's prayer requests.
