- Open with prayer.
- If your groups is new, give everyone time to introduce themselves.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

- What's one thing you're looking forward to in the future?
- Share something new or a highlight from this past week.

REVIEW

Open your Bibles and read from **2 Samuel 11:1-17**.

- Share your favourite points from the weekend sermon. What spoke to you?
- Share a phrase or moment that you related to the most, or a question you may have from the weekend.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- When have things been going really well in your life and then one poor decision has created a mess of things?
- How could David imagine that he could get away with such actions? How often do we think we can get away with our poor decisions?
- How do you imagine Bathsheba felt about this whole affair?
- Who do you identify with most in this story?
- God is always giving us a way of escape. How has that looked like in your life?
- When have you experienced God redeem a tragedy and bring hope in your life?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?

PRAISE & PRAYER POINTS

Share what God is doing in your life and spend some time praying for each other's prayer requests.
