THURSDAY: THE PLOT THICKENS

What does Maundy Thursday mean? Jesus' friends sit with Him for Passover – what will be The Last Supper they share. Then someone leaves the table, and a lot happens in the hours ahead ...

- Open with prayer.
- If your group is new, give everyone time to introduce themselves.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

- What's one thing you're looking forward to in the future?
- Share something new or a highlight from this past week.

REVIEW

Open your Bibles and read from **Luke 22:7-54 & John 13:34-35**

- Share your favourite points from the weekend sermon. What spoke to you?
- Share a phrase or moment that you related to the most, or a question you may have from the weekend.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- When you were growing up, what were mealtimes like?
- How do you think Jesus felt at his “last supper”?
- Why do you think the Lord’s Supper is important to believers? What does sharing in Communion or the Lord’s Supper mean to you? When did it take on a personal meaning for you?
- Jesus came as one who serves, calling us to follow His example. In what ways do you find it difficult to serve? Easy to serve?
- How is God calling you to make your life more service-oriented?
- Read John 13:34-35. What words or phrases stand out to you? What does it look like to love one another?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?

PRAISE & PRAYER POINTS

Share what God is doing in your life and spend some time praying for each other’s prayer requests.
