- In your journey with God, would you say that you searching or following? Why?
- How are you like the Magi? Unlike them? How should our response to Jesus look like the Magi's response?
- How does Matthew point to Jesus' kingship in this passage?
- What does the Magi's response to Jesus teach us about His significance?
- What is the "gold and frankincense and myrrh" in your life? Is there anything you want to offer Jesus now?
- Be generous this Christmas season. Ask God to give you the name of someone in need and reach out to them with a helpful gift.
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?
