Read through the list below and have each person choose one of the following activities. Keep an open mind and allow the Holy Spirit to lead and guide you. Feel free to make up one of your own!

- 1. Speak or write a daily word of encouragement to someone in your office.
- 2. Learn how to share the gospel in a sincere and helpful way.

- ✔ Learn from Jesus: Read Luke 18:18-30
- ✔ Do it!
- Referees seldom receive anything but verbal assaults. Doesn't matter if it was a ball or strike, foul, pick, first down, or turnover. Keep your complaints to yourself and personally show your appreciation to the refs when the match has ended.
- 4. Around one in four people in the world do not have access to the Bible or church communities nearby. Check out the Wycliffe Organization as they bring the good news to unreached people groups around the world!

- 5. It's disheartening to view national news and feel you are too small and remote to have any real impact. Instead, try watching

the local news as a group, and consider which of the stories you could get involved in by helping the person who is the subject. Don't forget to pray for each person in the spotlight – politicians, leaders, citizens, the TV anchors/hosts ... Wouldn't it be amazing to see God transform their lives?

- 6. Download the free Joshua Project app and pray for the leastreached groups of the world featured each day.
- 7. The Scriptures say it's a pretty good idea to be "quick to listen and slow to speak" (James 1:19). This week hold your tongue in arguments, even when you think you are in the right. Once you have listened, calmed down, and prayed about your response, then speak your mind. Be the active peacemaker in conflict.
- 8. Take the kids to storytime at your local library and get to know other parents.
