

One Anothers

A

Accept one another, then just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God. (*Romans 15:7*)

I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you **agree with one another** so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought. (*1 Corinthians 1:10*)

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and **admonish one another** with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. (*Colossians 3:16*)

B

Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, **bearing with one another** in love. (*Ephesians 4:2*)

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. (*Colossians 3:13*)

C

So there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should **have equal concern for each other**. (*1 Corinthians 12:25*)

Be kind and **compassionate to one another**, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. (*Ephesians 4:32*)

Therefore **confess your sins to each other** and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective. (*James 5:16*)

D

Be **devoted to one another** in brotherly love. Honour one another above yourselves. (*Romans 12:10*)

E

Therefore **encourage one another** and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing. (*1 Thessalonians 5:11*)

But **encourage one another** daily, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. (*Hebrews 3:13*)

Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us **encourage one another** – and all the more as you see the Day approaching. *(Hebrews 10:25)*

F

Be kind and compassionate to one another, **forgiving each other**, just as in Christ God forgave you. *(Ephesians 4:32)*

G

Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings. *(Romans 16:16)*

H

Live in **harmony with one another**. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited. *(Romans 12:16)*

Finally, all of you, **live in harmony** with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble. *(1 Peter 3:8)*

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. **Honour one another** above yourselves. *(Romans 12:10)*

Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. *(1 Peter 4:9)*

I

I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to **instruct one another**. *(Romans 15:14)*

K

Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be **kind to each other** and for everyone else. *(1 Thessalonians 5:15)*

L

“A new command I give you: **Love one another**. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” *(John 13:34-35)*

Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever **loves others** has fulfilled the law. *(Romans 13:8)*

Above all, **love each other** deeply because love covers over a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8)

P

"Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at **peace with each other**. (Mark 9:50)

Now we ask you, brothers, to respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you. Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. **Live in peace with each other**.

(1 Thessalonians 5:12-13)

You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, **serve one another** in love.

(Galatians 5:13)

Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord. (Ephesians 5:19)

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. (Ephesians 5:21)

And let us consider how we may **spur one another on** toward love and good deeds. (Hebrews 10:24)
