- How would you describe your relationship with the Holy Spirit?
- Do you ever struggle to trust the promptings of the Holy Spirit or the promises of God in your life?
- Are there people or teachers in your life who have helped you to see God at work in your life? What did they share with you that made a difference?
- How have you experienced the Holy Spirit's activity in your life, even if you didn't know at the time that it was him?
- Would you like to experience more of God through his Holy Spirit? What would this look like for you?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?

PRAISE & PRAYER POINTS

Share what God is doing in your life and spend some time praying for each other's prayer requests.
