- Do you believe in the concept of “soul-mate”? Why or why not?
- How would you describe the difference between a relationship that is Christ-centred and a relationship that is self-centred? What can we do to make sure our relationships stay Christ-centered?
- Have you ever been loved when you were at your weakest point? What was that like?
- How do we ensure our relationships have godly values?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?
