## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What do you like best about the hometown where you grew up?
- What is the difference between being a devoted follower or simply a fan of Jesus?
- In verses 18-21, Jesus shares 5 points from an Old Testament passage regarding his mission. Of these, which do you have a need for, either physically or spiritually?
- Talk together about some of the things that the Messiah would do. How did Jesus fulfill these? Why do you think he said these things were fulfilled in their hearing?
- How have you been cared for recently? In what ways can we care for others?
- Who is oppressed today that Jesus wants us to partner with him in freeing?
- What are some other ways that we can participate in Jesus' mission today?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?
