DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How does this description of love challenge you?
- What do you think Jesus' main point is in this passage?
- Have you ever shown love to an enemy? What happened?

- What does Christ say will happen to those who show love to others, especially their enemies?
- What habits do you need to change to reflect what Christ taught about loving your enemies and giving selflessly and sacrificially?
- How do these verses apply to your life? What will you do about it?
