or as long as I can remember, I've wanted to be a wife and a mother. As an adolescent, I fed my desire with romance novels. By the time I was in my late teens, I could not imagine a future without marriage, especially the sex part! When I found myself single in my early 20s, I started questioning God – how could He have put these desires in me and not do anything to fulfill them?! I felt unseen and unwanted. I became disappointed in God, angry that the desires He had placed in me were not being met.

Believing that physical intimacy was the answer, I became involved in a sexual relationship with a female friend. It was

exciting at first – I felt like a whole new world had opened up for me. Over time, however, I started to realize that this was not my true identity. I still had a hunger in me, a sense of a deep unmet need. My thoughts turned back to God. Maybe He was what I was missing. I remained very angry – a big part of me blamed God for my situation.

Although it was incredibly difficult, I made the decision to leave the relationship and move back in with my parents. Almost immediately, I started to experience God's presence in ways I never had before! Every church service I attended was a powerful worship experience. I still had deep desires for marriage and motherhood and sex, but as I leaned on God, I started to realize that no matter what – even if I remained single – I would be okay.
