Born and raised in Western Africa, I spent the first 23 years of my life feeling confused about my gender identity. My mother told me as soon as I could speak clearly, I often asked, "Why am I a girl?" Then I would say, "There's been a mistake."


remember feeling frustrated, trapped, and anxious at various stages of my life, because I didn't want to be a girl. I desperately hoped and prayed for miraculous gender transformation. After puberty, my discontentment increased as I felt hopelessly trapped in a girl's body.

I had accepted Jesus at age 10, and committed to following Him when I was 18 years old. In the midst of my firm belief in the Lord, my gender identity continued to be a struggle; I remained secretly disgruntled, and anxious about the future. I dreaded the thought of ever being in an intimate relationship, though I still hoped one day I would find love and have a family of my own. My family were the only ones who knew my story and always supported and prayed for me, even when I had given up.

As I grew spiritually, I realized this was not God's will for my life, and I began to pray for a breakthrough. One day, I felt the Holy Spirit say, "Just ask Me, and I will take it away." So I asked, and God gave me joy and peace like I had never felt before. I could finally look forward to the rest of my life and feel comfortable in my own skin.

I am now married to a lovely man and we have been blessed with two beautiful children. We have had our challenges along the way, **but our faithful God continues to see us through. His name be praised always!** *-Tolu*
