One Woman's Story



I was no stranger to dysfunction growing up. When I was a child I was abused and as a young teenager, raped. These were a few of many factors that made me vulnerable to exploitation. I began working for an escort agency when I was 18. Involvement in this industry led me from self-exploitation to pimp-exploitation and being trafficked against my knowledge or will. I was forced to work on the street. Everything I ate or smoked or any movement was controlled. I had to escape as the violence escalated. With

the help of another woman being prostituted, I did.

I ended up back in the sex industry, as my understanding of healthy belonging had become so distorted. By choice I began distancing myself from the toxic things within my life and decided to have a baby. I am on a continued journey of healing and transformation. Recovery from trauma, addiction, and exploitation is an important part of my story. CHILL, a local non-profit, has become part of my story; for the first time ever I felt valued as a person and for my experiences. **The CHILL team introduced me to Jesus and I have received His continual healing and freedom.** There has been a lifting of my soul and I do not feel the heaviness I once did. I love what Jesus is doing in my life. I am finding my identity in Jesus.
