ON MISSION ... *One Step at a Time*



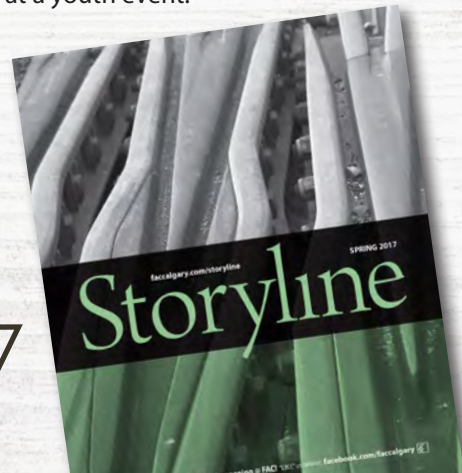
