Liam* recalls his time as an intern doing development work in a rural area with an international worker couple in Asia.

What kept you going in moments of discouragement? Every day on my way home, I walked by a little shack. It was so poorly built that I could see light spill through the slits in the wood. This village regularly had nights that reached -16 °C, and all this family had for warmth was a fire.

The owners of this shack worked from sun-up into the night, every single day. They are the definition of the working poor. I realized many of my moments of discouragement were a result of having such an easy life in Canada. Whenever I face discouragement, I think back to that family in the shack and remember I have so much to be grateful for.

Looking back, what did you learn from your internship?

Development work is a slow process but completely worth it. Make yourself available and God will use you.


Was it difficult to adjust back to Western culture?

The hardest part was getting used to the consumerism again. Living abroad, I was completely removed from consumerism. For the eight months I was there I was completely content, which was something I had never experienced before.

What do you want to say to those considering an internship?

Do it. It's scary, it's a big step, and it might just be the hardest thing you have ever done, but it will mostly likely be one of the most rewarding experiences you will ever have, and it is going to change your life.
