ON MISSION ... Wherever I Am



Being on mission in my own city and in this world never truly occurred to me until my discipleship training at YWAM (Youth with a Mission) in Argentina in 2014, where God showed me His heart for the world as well as His heart to see me, His servant, do His work for the glory of the Lord. This six-month experience changed my perspective on my life completely, as I allowed for the presence of the Lord to speak into me about His plans for my future. When I allowed the Lord to take control, it amazed me how He began to speak into my life so clearly.

I will never forget when God spoke to me vocally during a time of prayer. We were surrounded by paintings in the room, and

we were told to ask God to lead us to one painting to direct our prayer. God guided me to a painting of a little girl in Cambodia that was sexually exploited. Ultimately, through other confirmations from God, my YWAM experience gave me the heart for those that face sexual exploitation, and the desire to want to serve my Lord and be a missionary to wherever He calls me.

Since my YWAM experience, my perspective of being on mission has continued to grow. This past year, God asked me what I'm doing to be on mission when I am not overseas in the summer. My answer: not enough. I began to explore how I can use my desires and passion for justice in my own city. God directed me to CHILL (Christ Heals in Low Lights), a non-profit organization journeying with individuals affected by sexual exploitation right here in Calgary. Even though I plan to be a missionary internationally, being on mission is still applicable wherever I am. - Jeff Romanuk
