# the presence of God



'm a skeptic at heart – let me start with that ...

Our grade fiver, Jonah (the one with the broken hand), woke up this morning just before 6:00. When he got up the cast/splint that was wrapped around his hand was laid, with the 7 different layers of wrapping, neatly in a pile beside his bed. There's no way that it could have all come off by accident in his sleep. He just got it on last week, and it was supposed to be on for 3-4 weeks.

"Dad, I felt overwhelmed by the presence of God when I got up and I heard an audible voice that said, 'You asked for healing – it's healed.' I don't feel any pain anymore, and look – I can straighten my hand ... I couldn't do that before."

Karla and I tested his hand, he squeezed my fingers with full strength, we pushed on the part where the break happened –

and still no pain. He rotated his wrist around with no pain.

He asked if he should wear his cast/splint. We said no. Karla reminded him of the stories of Jesus telling people to get up and walk, and they ran ... **They didn't hold onto their crutches – they proclaimed the glory of God.** 

As I sit here in tears, writing about the reality of God's kingdom in our life this morning ... to God be the glory!
