My Journey



When my journey led back to God, I had no idea what was in store for me. I knew faith in God and Jesus would help me, but I didn't know how. When people talked about personal encounters with God, I never thought I would have one – until I did. Here are some excerpts from what I wrote down after my awesome experience with God.

"... God came to me. He spoke to me so loudly I couldn't sleep ... His words were very clear ... He gave me specific instructions, and they would not leave my head until I wrote them down ... He allowed me to feel real anger, which I hadn't felt in years. He told me I would eventually forgive, but I should focus on other things first ..."

"... I felt the Holy Spirit in me as He drew out the ties that were holding me down. It was like a fog lifted, and I could see everything more clearly. He helped me visualize and internalize the destructive patterns I kept repeating ... **He told me that I was worthy of His love and that I was strong** ..."

"**God gave me clarity**. My eyes and heart are now open to live my fullest life. To nurture others and to focus on the family I have right now ... my son needs me to love myself the way God loves me, without conditions or reservations."

When my faith starts to fade, I go back to my writing to remember how He healed me.
