Why go to work?



After years of consulting and working from my home office, I accepted a full-time assignment at a large engineering services firm five years ago to raise money for a Compassion trip to El Salvador. Just a temporary gig in Cubicle World.

Grateful for the work God provided, I imagined I would learn some new skills, make some money, make a difference in El Salvador, and move on.

I prayed daily that God would help me do my best work, and that He would use me. One day in January, a new colleague and friend said she'd enjoyed an FAC Christmas production I'd sung in.

A manager poked his head into my cubicle later and said, "I couldn't help but overhear you talking about First Alliance." We talked about church and faith and I learned Dave not only knew my Heavenly Father, he knew my earthly dad, too. Dave asked, "Want to join a small group I'm starting this Thursday?"

Thursday's lunch began a four-year weekly meeting, where we ate together, prayed for our colleagues and each other, encouraged each other, challenged each other, and studied a booklet called "Why Go To Work?"

The author says since God promises to provide for our needs, our purpose for going to work is not to make money—it's to be His representative in the workplace. What a disruptive idea!

Our group agreed to keep each other accountable to do excellent work, build real relationships, and not be pompous spiritual jerks. As we built relationships, spiritual conversations naturally bubbled up.

We weathered the storms of everyday work life together until our time at that company ended. The economy launched us like dandelion seeds, the winds blowing us into new places to take root and make a difference. -Heather Traub
