Praise God, our Friday Night Salon Outreach is ramping Up! Some weeks can feel so overwhelming as we walk down the gauntlet of human brokenness and spiritual oppression on our way to the salon where we offer free hair

**and nails** to women and "lady boys" (transgender people referred to as female) who work in the sex trade. Despite occasional feelings of heaviness, we know **God is always working** and drawing these beloved people of His to Himself, and we're so **privileged** to be a part of it! Last Friday, we had 10-12 women come, many of whom were **repeat attenders** or came by word of mouth, and we had some great conversations and times of sharing the gospel and praying with them.

**Please pray** for God's **covering** over this ministry and our **growing relationship** with these women.

I'm also going to start **teaching English** to some women from the bars starting this Wednesday. God uses our weakness to bring himself glory, so **please pray** he gets a lot of glory because I feel weak as an English teacher!
