This spring break I went on the SHS missions trip to Cienfuegos, Cuba, and had many memorable experiences. The common union of our two church groups broke down the language barrier because we were united in Christ. Whether it was the work effort or socializing as a youth community, Canadians and Cubans all connected and it was a great experience to just be with them and worship Christ together.

One of the things that impacted me the most was recognizing how little wealth the Cubans had. However, it did not affect their happiness. I recognized as Canadians we have so much but because we focus on these things it prevents us from feeling happiness like the freedom the Cuban people had.

The greatest experience I had happened in a moment during a Sunday church service. Some of our team was asked to lead singing during worship. The group chose the song "How Great is Our God." A few Cubans in the congregation who understood English recognized the song and echoed the song in Spanish. The rest of the Cuban congregation joined in. During those few minutes of singing, I felt God's love pouring into everyone's hearts. We were not just Canadians and Cubans; we were all God's children who He loves.

This memorable trip has taught me to see beyond my personal struggles and instead to trust that God has a plan for my life. "God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God." (1John 4:16)
