n my travels as a volunteer ambassador for Compassion I've been impressed by the tenacious potential God has implanted in each heart He has created. grown up in Compassion's Child Development Program. My question was answered resoundingly. Yes. Great good can come from great evil when God is invited in. One of the young women at our table that evening shared how she was abused in every way as a young girl. The Compassion project was the only place she felt safe and loved. The help and hope she received there gave her the confidence and ability to attend medical school—and lead 9 of her family members to Jesus. She was planning to practice medicine in the type of community where she was raised and become a part of the solution to the complex problems she knew all too well.

Children grow up. They can either become a part of the solution or continue to be tangled in the problems they are born into. Partnering with Compassion has enabled me to experience the joy of seeing light outshine darkness, and hope overcome despair.
