

n North American culture, we find that much of the Bible's references to suffering are viewed through a

lens that interprets it as something very different than what so many other Christians in other parts of the world who endure. Physical attacks, imprisonment, torture, and in case you haven't been watching the news, martyrdom.

Persecution as defined in scripture encompasses a range of hostility aimed at the believer – social discrimination, ridicule and harassment causing psychological harm increasing to physical violence, torture and murder.

Many Christians grow stronger in their faith after persecution and reading and watching the testimonies of the heavily persecuted and the grace they have shown their

persecutors can lead one to question one's own faithfulness and commitment to following Christ. What does it really mean to take up a cross? (Matthew 16:24) What does it mean if you don't?

God has placed the responsibility on us, the body, to make known the Gospel, and to encourage and stand beside others who are living in or facing trials and tribulations on behalf of Christ.

Remember the prisoners, as though in prison with them, and those who are ill-treated, since you yourselves also are in the body. (Hebrews 13:3)

No matter where the Voice of the Martyrs ministers, the first request of persecuted Christians is always the same: "Pray for us." And if you move that prayer beyond one day a year, your faith will never be the same.
