By my mid-teens I had totally retreated from the Christian life. Drugs and alcohol seemed the only way to find a connection. In the darkness I turned to God because I knew a relationship with Him was the only escape from death. God led me to Teen Challenge to build that relationship.

<u>I have been restored back</u> to a place where I can have great conversations with people without drugs, where before I could not. I am pushing through struggles that I never thought possible. I realize that I love spending time in community and hope to be involved in some form of ministry after graduation.
