
Giving Update

It was a station transmitting in Romanian, from somewhere in Europe. It was called illegal in our country but people would still listen, despite the real risk of being caught and persecuted.



The next days I continued to listen to the radio.

And what I heard then froze the blood in my veins.

The army started to shoot people on the streets. I couldn't believe it ... Was that true?

Even so, people couldn't be stopped. They were ready to take the bullets but not to shut up anymore. And that was the beginning of the Romanian revolution.

It happened the same in my city. Everybody went on the streets. Me, too.

So I went on the streets and I marched directly to the City Hall, where all the action was. Thousands of people in front of the army tanks. Me, among them. 
