I have learned that the way to access God's promises is by studying scripture. Presently I am enjoying the Precept Studies where I am forced to search out more Biblical truth for myself. **It's so exciting to know God speaks to me through His Word.**

Jesus, in His first sermon on Kingdom life, said, "Blessed (happy) are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied." (Matthew 5:6)
