'm a musician from Seattle, but my fulltime work has always been with corporate teams. A few years ago an opportunity emerged with a startup, which I moved across the country to pursue.

Strangely, it all fell apart, and soon I was back in Seattle at Microsoft, feeling like a failure.

To make matters worse, my new job was with a design studio that felt completely foreign despite my corporate experience. Their language and way of working were unfamiliar. But I had to learn quickly: they needed help reconnecting with the industry and defining their values during a time of massive change. It was a crashcourse in culture-making, and it was hard work.

Two years passed. Then last spring a small church asked if I would

lead worship temporarily as they finished their hiring process. Months into that work, I got another urgent call from a church across town, and another call came after that. A new vocation was emerging. And suddenly all of that corporate training became invaluable, as each ministry opportunity that opened up for me required a focus on culture, especially for teams in transition.

What felt like the death of a dream was really a challenge to my identity. God created something beautiful from that discouraging season and reaffirmed my worth along the way. As an artist in residence at FAC, I'm excited to learn together how God is growing the arts in this culture and how He is affirming our identity in the process.
