Lloyd's Story



Dad was the Canadian manager of a large insurance company and member of several international boards. He was very successful, though never wealthy. In his late 50s Dad left the corporate world to work for Canadian Bible College (now Ambrose University). The first Sunday after he left, the plate was being passed and Dad had made out his offering cheque – based on his previous salary. Suddenly it dawned on him that his new salary was only 1/3 of the previous one. **He decided to trust God** and continued to give what he'd given before. God constantly provided. Somehow the money just went farther.

Years later hard times hit. Dad borrowed money to help other people invest in a mine operated by a major contributor of the college. Tragedy struck and the mine closed. He had to sell the house to pay off his debt. John 15:1-2 says, "I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener ... He prunes the branches that bear fruit so they will produce even more." Rather than becoming bitter, Dad saw this as God's pruning so that he could produce more fruit. The fruit: the chance to tell others what God did for him during that difficult time. Dad says, "**God's presence and care were so real.** This principle can apply no matter what your need is. It doesn't have to be money." Now in his late 90s, Dad continues to savour God's presence and care.
