have been blessed to serve Christ as a pediatrician, a life coach, and the author of a book dealing with ways to always move forward. The idea of the book's title (Moving Forward) came to me during one of the 100 marathons I have run thus far.

We all are called to be ministers of God, but there are days we feel stuck; moving forward is hard and we

are tired. We want to walk instead of run, and some just want to drop out and hide somewhere in shame. To obey the words of Christ in Luke 6:27-47 (written in red in my Bible) is basically impossible – unless we allow Jesus to infuse us with inner strength (Phil. 4:13 Amp Bible).

Three years ago, my wife almost died because her heart raced too fast. God showed us His favour and mercy, and with the help of competent physicians and a pacemaker she is well, serving as a doctor and a parent. We know what it means to move forward, confident that Jesus is Lord and that there is no better Comforter than the Holy Spirit who guides us in all things.

My favorite meditation in my study at dawn is to visualize the face of Jesus when He plainly tells us about His peace (John 14:27). As a doctor, I prescribe this activity often. It works.
