

# SAD HAPPY TRAVELS by Shirley Thiessen

A series of "sappy" moments characterized our family's recent trip to Thailand in February. What is sappy? It's when the emotions of sadness and happiness co-exist in the same moment ... Sad + Happy = Sappy.

Three and a half years ago, my newly-married son, Jordan, tragically died in a workplace accident. Our lives were turned upside down. For Jordan's bride, Elise, her heart filled with dreams for their future as a couple was shattered. The pain was excruciating.

Early in our grief journey, I encouraged Elise to volunteer at Mercy Ministries' Babies' Home in Thailand where our friend, Marg Baker, is raising orphaned children to know the love of Jesus. Knowing Marg to be an exceptional, godly mentor to scores of young adults who have volunteered in her Thai home



over the past sixteen years, I longed for Elise to have the same life-giving experience. I was confident Elise would benefit from Marg's insightful wisdom, born out of her own suffering. Like no one else I know, Marg wears beautifully the fragrance of Christ. It's undeniable. It's compelling. It's inspirational.

God effectively used Marg and the children to begin Elise's journey towards healing. As a result of her trip to Thailand, Elise returned home feeling quite certain that God was directing her next step and it included teaching children. Attending Ambrose University for a two-year educational degree, Elise became certified as an elementary teacher.
