MEET ALEX, OUR STUDENT MINISTRIES INTERN



Vocational church ministry has been a somewhat recent calling in my life. Before beginning a ministry education with Ambrose University, I had the privilege of serving with youth organizations like the YMCA of Northern Alberta, and the Edmonton Police Service's Neighborhood Empowerment Team (NET) and Cadet Leadership Program. With those organizations I experienced the power of one-on-one discipleship relationships.

I had opportunities to connect one-on-one with students over physical fitness. As a conditioning coach I had the privilege of encouraging students with self-discipline, healthy physical development, and an active lifestyle. With the YMCA, I supervised youth leadership programs that focused on building life skills such as career counseling alongside social and interpersonal development. With the NET team I had the opportunity to help students make a positive impact within their schools and community.

However, I've learned that it's great to empower students with confidence in skill development, but it's so much more amazing to help them realize how loved they are and how accepted they are, not through works but through the Gospel.

John 10:1-18 describes us as sheep – insufficient sheep that need the guidance of a good shepherd. It says **the good Shepherd gives us an identity, names us, and redeems us**. Our worldview often tells us, "Do this, and then you will be accepted." Our faith reminds us to first seek Jesus Christ to see what He has done and to actively receive acceptance. The gospel reminds us to be accepted; then we're free to do good.

Serving with the Student Ministries team at FAC helps me walk that talk. I'm so thankful for this learning opportunity. I'm thankful to serve alongside gospel-centered leaders to serve and encourage the growing generation of students.
