Calgary Dream Centre

My name is Alejandro and the Calgary Dream Centre saved my life.

Growing up in Mexico in an abusive home, I felt worthless. I started drinking at 13 to hide from the pain. I struggled with anger and depression so I felt like drinking and partying gave me a place in the world and an identity that I never felt I had before. I was kicked out at 17 and I went to a very dark place for the next few years where I had multiple overdoses and tried to commit suicide three times.

At 22 I moved to Canada to try to find a new life. However, my depression, addiction, and suicidal thoughts followed me all the way here. I felt angry that I couldn't get my depression to go away so I did anything I could to stop myself from feeling—cocaine, alcohol, anything. I did that for almost a year. I eventually ended up homeless and busking in the streets when a lady invited me to her church. I don't know what she saw in me; my body was falling apart and I had rotten teeth—but she invited me in, fed me, and helped me realize I was worth something. I accepted Jesus and I realized I was worth changing my life.

March 12, 2016 I joined the Youth Addiction Recovery Program and my life is changed. **This program taught me about the love of God while giving me knowledge about the disease of addiction.** The Dream Centre is a gift from heaven in my life. They have provided me a place to live, recovery, a job, but most of all the belief that I am worthy of a full life. Thank you to the Dream Centre for saving my life.
