DiscoveryLand RELAUNCH PHASE 1 FAQs

What should I expect when I arrive for the service at FAC?

At the building entrance you'll be asked the COVID-19 screening questions and invited to sanitize your hands. You will then be directed to a DiscoveryLand check-in kiosk. Once you have the grade school child's nametags, the child and one adult will go to the DiscoveryLand Grade School area. At the DiscoveryLand entrance, the child's temperature will be taken. Once you arrive at the classroom, a leader will take one of the nametags and direct the child to a seating area.

What will happen during the service time?

DiscoveryLand might look a little different, but it's still the same great program kids love! There are worship songs that kids can do the actions to, a great teach time, fun small group activities and toys and games to play with. Activities will not require touching, crowding or sharing supplies and equipment.

Are small groups divided by grade?

Children in Grades 1 – 4 will be in combined age groups.

Can my child sit and play with their siblings or friends?

Children in the same family or in a family bubble cohort, will be able to sit together and play freely with each other. So you may want to coordinate with your child's 'bubble family' and plan to attend the same service!

What if my child doesn't come with a sibling or friend?

Children who attend without a family cohort will be assigned to a seating area with other children without a family cohort. Each child will have their own toy bin and activities, and will be seated six feet away. Group activities will still encourage children to interact with each other, but just a little farther apart.

What do I do for pick-up?

Only one adult should return to their child's classroom for pick-up, following the directional signs. At the classroom, show your pick-up badge to the volunteer. Please pick up your child promptly after service to give us adequate time to clean between services.

What are the safety and cleaning procedures in DiscoveryLand?

Everyone is required to wear a face mask in the building. The DiscoveryLand program will operate at 50% capacity to allow for increased physical distancing. Classroom surfaces and toys will be disinfected before the next service. Children will be encouraged to do the actions to the songs, but not to sing.
