1. Philosophy of Ministry

TEAM MINISTRY

- d. **Motive:** Not greedy or motivated from compulsion, eager to serve with the right attitude and for the right reasons.

FIRST ALLIANCE CHURCH OBJECTIVES

Ministry staff is committed to **building lives that honour God**. To accomplish this purpose, ministry activities are focused on our five biblically-based life commitments aimed to build lives that:

- a. **HONOUR:** We will create environments where personal and corporate expressions of devotion to Christ are natural and normal.
- b. **CONNECT:** We will create environments where connection to Christ and His body are natural, intentional and authentic.
- c. **GROW:** We will create contagious environments where growing into Christ-likeness is natural, normal and expected.
- d. **SERVE:** We will create environments and provide opportunities for each person to discover and use their God-given abilities for His glory.
- e. **SHARE:** We will create environments and provide opportunities where sharing the love of Christ is natural and normal both locally and around the world. We will willingly share our resources, experiences and giftedness to train and encourage people whose intent is sharing the love of God.



PRIMARY TASK

The primary task of a ministry staff person is to help meet the goals of the church by recruiting, equipping and assisting lay leaders to develop and implement effective church ministries. This will take place through a variety of avenues with an emphasis on small groups as our primary method of implementation

2. Position Purpose & Responsibilities

To contribute to First Alliance Church overall vision and mission fulfillment by developing and implementing ministry and strategies for your scope of responsibilities. The specific areas for which you will be held responsible and accountable are defined as:

All Staff

- Develop annual ministry goals, plans, strategies and event calendars for ministry area responsibilities
- Guide the effective implementation of ministry plans
- Ensure maintenance of accurate statistical records for ministry area activity
- Evaluate effectiveness of programming within your ministry area
- Be in agreement with the Christian & Missionary Alliance statement of faith and be able to sign the First Alliance Church covenant
- Participate in all staff meetings, retreats, training and global events
- Maintain a lifestyle consistent with biblical standards for Christian behaviour
- Attend our weekend worship services as laid out in our current staff policy
- Participate in the development of Next Gen leaders at every opportunity

Role Specifics

- Create video assets that support the music program at FAC, including music videos, live performance videos, lyric videos, "Canvas" videos for Spotify, behind-the-scenes interviews and footage documenting music creation processes.
- Develop and implement an ongoing, sustainable video production initiative as an expression of FAC music
- Recruit, develop, schedule and manage volunteers to lead the initiative, including storyboard developers, camera operators and video editors.
- Collaborate with local church tech department to synergize goals, maximize stewardship of equipment, and ensure cross-departmental success
- Assist in the creative development of original video ideas
- Other related duties as required



Requirements

- Passionate about video creation
- Experienced in the operation of video editing software (preferably Adobe Premiere Pro or similar)
- Experienced in basic video recording techniques
- Preference given to students who already have produced some video assets
- Knows basic storyboarding techniques and understands how to creatively tell stories through video
- Can give leadership and direction to other video production personnel
- Works well both independently and in a collaborative creative environment
- Demonstrates strong personal initiative (self-starter) and follow-through
- Good interpersonal and communication skills
- Able to meet deadlines
- Preference given to students who have access to their own video recording and editing equipment
