Role Specifics

Pastoral Leadership

- Provide primary pastoral care to senior adults and their families with special care in times of illness, bereavement and family crisis, including hospital visitation, presiding at funerals and facilitating memorials. The goal is to help seniors finish well!
- Recruit, train and mobilize teams who will regularly visit and/or call shut-ins and provide continued care and community for those who can no longer attend church.
- Assist teams to lead, preach, sing, play instruments and assist residents to and from Care home Chapel services.
- Organize and oversee a monthly large group fellowship and worship event and additional programming and activities as needed.
- Partner with the Connect team in facilitating seniors' Small Group involvement.
- Paying attention to the role and call of grandparents in the life of a family and helping increase awareness and giftedness to this important role for FAC grandparents.

General Pastoral Duties

- Perform pastoral duties as a member of the FAC pastoral team including weddings, funerals, baby dedications, baptisms, hospital visits and other duties that arise from time to time. This includes pastoral counseling, spiritual direction and assessing immediate needs.
- To network both denominationally and inter-denominationally with other Family Ministries pastors

Requirements:

- In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada
- Must be licensed or able to be licensed with the C&MA in Canada
- A degree in a ministry related field and/or 3+ years of experience
- Be in agreement with the Christian & Missionary Alliance statement of faith and be able to sign the First Alliance Church covenant
- Leadership experience leading a spiritually healthy and effective community
- Highly self-motivated with a commitment to excellence and creativity
- Team player with a pastor's heart
- Demonstrated capacity to build and release leaders and for creating/shaping ministry and culture
- Deep relationship with Jesus that forms and informs all aspects of life with a passion for renewal
- Dependent on interaction with outside agencies, this position may require the applicant to be fully vaccinated to carry out assigned duties as they relate to the guidelines of these agencies.
