- Supplied SNACK AND LUNCH BAGS to kids and families 1 day/week at 2 Calgary locations
- SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS: Hosted end-of-theyear meals for school staff in Forest Lawn & Ogden, and provided winter gear for kids in need.

Refugee Ministry

- 45 REFUGEES SETTLED into Alberta with FAC as the Sponsorship Agreement Holder:
 14 from Eritrea, 9 from Afghanistan, 9 from Ethiopia.
- Yonnas, our first fully FAC-sponsored refugee since before the COVID-19 pandemic, arrived safely in Calgary in May of 2023. He attends FAC Southwest, and English classes on Monday evenings at FAC Deerfoot.

Global Engagement

- \$2,563 raised for Artisan Ministries at FAC INTERNATIONAL
- \$29,379 raised for UKRAINE RELIEF FUND
- \$4,205 raised for UKRAINE MEDIA PROJECT
- \$12,500 sent from the Missions Fund to purchase a NEW CONVOY VEHICLE for medical, food, and essential supplies into Ukraine



We've also been able to participate in OPERATION
 AFGHAN SAFETY, which brings Afghans who are
 religious minorities, human rights defenders,
 or female leaders to Canada. We received 15
 allocations for this program in 2023 for a total of
 45 allocations and have been informed by IRCC that
 all OAS cases should arrive in Canada by the end of
 December 2023.
