

- An average of 30 families per week received food hampers at the NEW COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTRE (FAC Deerfoot) in partnership with Calgary Food Bank.

 counselling referrals, scholarships to Camp

Refugee Ministry

NEWCOMERS WERE WELCOMED to Alberta through our Refugee Sponsorship Program including 2 fully FAC-sponsored families from Iran and Syria. Most of the refugees are originally from Ethiopia, Afghanistan, Syria, and Eritrea.

Global Engagement

- **SHORT-TERM MISSION TRIPS** returned for the first time since 2019 with a team of 9 going to support our Inca Link partners in **Colombia**, March 22-April 1!
- 17 INTERNATIONAL WORKERS serving in Latin America, Middle East, Asia, Africa & Canada were supported through prayer & monthly financial support from the Missions Fund.
- FREEDOM WEEKEND in May featured our partnership with International Justice Mission, focussing on IJM's work in Guatemala.


